**RECRUITMENT FOR THE POST OF CONSTABLE (TRADESMAN) (MALE & FEMALE)
IN BORDER SECURITY FORCE FOR THE YEAR 2024-25**

Online applications are invited from MALE & FEMALE Indian Citizens for filling up 3588 Vacancies (3406 Vacancies for Male candidates and 182 Vacancies for Female candidates) for the post of Constable (Tradesman) Exam 2024-25 in Border Security Force in the pay Matrix Level-3. Pay scale Rs.21,700-99,100/- of 7th CPC (Revised Pay Structure) and other allowances as admissible to Central Govt. employees from time to time. In addition Ration allowance, Medical Assistance, free accommodation, free leave passes, etc. are granted which are admissible to BSF employees.

(State Wise, Trade Wise and Category wise distribution of vacancies for Male & Female candidates are attached at Appendix - 'A' & 'B')

(2) IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES FOR APPLYING FOR ABOVE POST:-

- i) BSF will conduct recruitment for the post of Constable(Tradesman) (Male & Female candidates) in BSF for the year 2024-2025
- ii) Before applying online application, Candidates are advised to go through the requirement of educational certificate, trade experience certificate, age, physical standards, physical efficiency test, etc and satisfy themselves that they are eligible for the post before applying. BSF reserves the right to cancel the candidature of any candidate at any stage of the selection process, if he/she is found not qualifying any of the prescribed eligibility criteria.
- iii) The recruitment will comprise of Physical Standard Test (PST), Physical Efficiency Test (PET), Written Examination, Documentation, Trade Test and Medical Examination (DME/RME).
- iv) Candidate will apply for only one post/trade.
- v) Qualifying the selection stages of recruitment process doesn't confer any right to candidates for appointment. Final selection of candidate will be made purely on merit.
- vi) State wise and trade wise vacancies are enclosed with Advertisement notice. A candidate has to apply against vacancies allocated to his/her homedomiciled State only.
- vii) When application is successfully submitted, it will be accepted provisionally. Candidate may take printout of the application form for their own records. Printout of the application form is not required to be submitted to BSF recruitment centres. Candidates are also advised to fill up their correct and active e-mail addresses and mobile number in the online application so that correspondence may be made through E-Mail/SMS.
- viii) Candidate should note down and retain 'Registration ID' and Password provided to them while making One-Time Registration which is required for filing online application.

- (iii) Only online application is to be submitted by a candidate. Therefore, the candidates are advised to exercise due diligence at the time of filling their application form. Also ensure that all the particulars of application form must be filled up as given in the matriculation certificate otherwise they may be rejected at the time of documentation or as and when it comes into the notice of the board.
- (iv) Candidates will fill up personal basic information through online in the application form with correct entry like name of the post, candidate's name, father's name, address, category, date of birth, marital status, mobile number, E-Mail address, educational qualification, trade experience certificate etc and thoroughly check all the entries.
- (v) Candidates to inform themselves from filing wrong information in their application form, uploading fake photograph of any other personality, dignitaries or object or put blank photo etc. suitable action will be taken against such defaulter candidates as per provisions under Cyber Crime Act 2006.
- (vi) Applications with illegible/blurred photographs/signature will be rejected.
- (vii) Candidates belonging to the Physically Handicapped category are not eligible to apply for this recruitment.
- (viii) An employee serving in the same rank and pay grade will not be entitled to apply for said post.
- (ix) Persons serving in Govt/Semi Govt department should apply after obtaining NOC. No objection Certificate(NOC) from their employer will be required with application form.
- (x) Candidate are required to upload their Educational certificates (Matriculation), trade experience certificate and other documents as per their category to support their claims. They should ensure that they fulfill all the eligibility conditions for admission to the posts. If during scrutiny of the online application, it is found that candidate does not fulfill any of the eligibility conditions, his/her application will be rejected by the Recruitment Selection Board.
- (xi) All eligible candidates who apply in response to this advertisement before the closing date will be assigned Roll Number, if they fulfill the term and condition as given in this advertisement and found eligible for the post. Only such eligible candidates will be communicated through E-Mail address/SMS for Call letters/Admit Cards through online mode for appearing in the first phase selection process. However any candidate found not eligible at later stage in any aspect, his/her candidature will be cancelled. The admit cards for all the phases of examination will be made/uploaded on the website only. Therefore candidates are advised to visit the BSF website regularly for upcoming latest information of all the phase of examination.
- (xii) The recruitment board shall not be liable for any claim arising out of any injury etc suffered during the tests. The decision of the recruitment board shall be final in all matters connected with this recruitment.
- (xiii) The appointment will be subject to the conditions that the candidates are medically as well as physically fit. The selected candidates will have to undergo Basic Training at any of the Training Institutions of BSF. The services of those candidates who fail to complete the training successfully are liable to be terminated.

(xxi)	Information regarding issue of Admit Card/Call letters and any other important information pertaining to recruitment will be sent on the e-mail address or mobile number of candidates given by the candidates at the time of One Time Registration (OTR). BSF will not be responsible for any technical issues arisen due to inactive e-mail address or invalid mobile numbers. Hence, candidates are advised to ensure that active e-mail ID and mobile number must be used for OTR.
(xxii)	Candidates shall have the choice to appear for the recruitment at only one centre i.e. the centre in which he/she opts while filling online application. The centre he/she opts will be his/her recruitment centre. No request for change of Recruitment centre will be allowed/accepted under any circumstances. The department reserves the right to cancel the centre and ask the candidates of that centre to appear at another centre. Department also reserve the right to divert candidates of any centre to some other centre to take the examination on administrative grounds.
(xxiii)	In case, candidates are appointed in BSF and subsequently seek resignation or discharge before completion of 10 years service, they shall be required to remit an amount equal to three months pay and allowances or the cost of training imparted to them, whichever is higher as per rules to the Government.
(xxiv)	On appointment they shall be covered under "New Restructured Defined Contributory Pension Scheme" or Uniform Pension Scheme (UPS), applicable for the new entrants to the Central Government services w.e.f 01 st Jan, 2004 and 01 st April 2025 respectively as per prevailing government rules and organizational policies.
(xxv)	Candidates seeking reservation benefits such as SC/ST/OBC/EWS (Annexure - II, III & VII) or any other relaxation as per the provision of the Notice of Examination must ensure that they are entitled to such reservation/relaxation. They should be issued caste certificates from prescribed/competent authority with authority of Govt. of India/Resolution correctly mentioned on it, which justifies the claim of candidate. Caste mentioned in the caste certificate must be recognized by the Central Govt. & enlisted in centralized list notified by the Central Govt. for respective State.
(xxvi)	The candidates belonging to the States will only be considered for recruitment against the vacancies of their domicile States on production of valid "Domicile Certificate" to prove their domiciliary status, issued by the Competent revenue authorities so authorized by the concerned State.
(xxvii)	The candidates of any reserved category (SC/ST/OBC/EWS) may apply from Un-Reserved category due to non-availability of vacancy in any particular trade or other reasons subject to fulfilling terms and conditions applicable for UR category candidate.
(xxviii)	Mobile phone and other Electronic Gadgets are banned within the premises of the Examination Centers.
(xxix)	The biometric methods will be used during all stages of the recruitment and at the time of joining of candidate (in the absence of computer based biometric equipments, thumb impression, digital photograph and any specific identifying marks in the body may be used).
(xxx)	Legal action will be taken against candidate(s) who are found to be indulged in procuring impersonation in any of the selection stages of recruitment and they will not be allowed to appear in subsequent stages of recruitment.

- (xxv) Written Examination will be conducted at the various Examination Centres through Computer Based Test (CBT) or OMR based answer sheets. OMR answer sheets will rejected if mandatory fields, such as Name, Roll Number, Sex, Category, Occupation Booklet series code, Name of Trade etc. are left blank or wrongly filled.
The written examination will be bilingual i.e. in English & Hindi.
Selected candidate will be governed by BSF Act and Rules.
Finally selected candidates are liable to be posted anywhere in the Country as per the transfer policy of the Force.
- (xxvi) At the time of final selection if any claim made in application is not found substantiated then the candidature will be cancelled and the decision of BSF authority in this regard shall be final.
- (xxvii) Admission of candidates to the recruitment centre will be purely subjected to production of all letter/ admit cards or copy of list of eligible candidates downloaded from BSF website in which his/her name appears.
- (xxviii) Candidates must carry atleast one photo bearing identity proofs such as Aadhar Card, Voter ID, Driving License, Identity card issued by University/College in original for producing before the selection board to validate their identity.
- (xxix) Following documents are mandatory to be uploaded with the online application form (a) 10th Pass certificate (to prove education & date of birth) (b) Course certificate in respective trade as asked (c) Domicile certificate of respective state (d) Cast certificate (if applicable) (e) Relaxation certificate (if applicable)

(D) WINDOW FOR ONLINE APPLICATION FORM CORRECTION (24-08-2025 TO 26-08-2025 | 23:00 HOURS)

After the closing date for receipt of Online Application Form, BSF will provide a period of 3 days to enable candidates to correct/modify Online Application form parameters wherein candidates will be allowed to re-submit online applications after making requisite corrections/changes in the one-time registration/Online Application Form data as per their requirement.

A candidate will be allowed to correct and re-submit his modified/ corrected Online Application Form during the 'Window for Application Form Correction' i.e., he/she will be allowed to re-submit modified/ corrected Online Application Form after making requisite corrections/ modifications. No more corrections in the application form will be allowed under any circumstances.

Only those candidates will be allowed to make corrections in the Online Application Form, whose completed Online Application Form along with payment of the non-refundable fee have been received by the CSC within the specified period.

An uniform correction charge of ₹100/- (Rupees One Hundred Only) for making a correction(s) and re-submitting modified/ corrected Online Application Form. The correction charges will be applicable to all candidates irrespective of their gender/ category.

- (v) The correction charges can be paid only by online mode through Net banking of any bank, Credit/Debit Card of any bank and nearest authorized Common Service Centre.
- (vi) The correction charge(s) once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances nor will it be adjusted against any other Examination or selection.
- (vii) Subject to the receipt of applicable correction charges, the latest modified corrected Online Application Form will be treated as the valid one and the previous application(s) submitted by such candidates will be canceled.
- (viii) If the applicable correction charges are not received by the CSC, the status of the Online Application Form is shown as 'Incomplete' and this information is printed on the top of the Online Application Form printed. Such Online Application Form shall not be accepted and the previously submitted Online Application Form will remain valid.
- (ix) Before submission of the corrected Online Application Form, candidates must check that they have filled correct details in each field of the Online Application Form. After the expiry of the 'Window for Application Form Correction' no change/ correction/ modification will be allowed under any circumstances. Requests received in this regard in any form like Post Fax, Email, by hand, etc. shall not be entertained by the BSF and will be summarily rejected.

(4) EXAMINATION FEE AND MODE OF PAYMENT

(a) Candidates belonging to Un-reserved (UR), EWS category or OBC category applying for recruitment to the posts shall have to deposit Rs. 100/- (Rupees One Hundred) only as examination fee plus Rs. 50/- (Rupees Fifty) plus 18% GST only service charges levied by Common Service Centre (CSC) through following payment mode :-

- (i) Net banking of any Bank
 - (ii) Credit/Debit Card of any Bank
 - (iii) Nearest authorized Common Service Centre
- (b) Women candidates and candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, BSF serving personnel and Ex-Servicemen are exempted from payment of examination fee.
- (c) Payment of examination fee will be accepted only through online mode.
- (d) Fee once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- (e) In case of non-receipt of examination fee from the candidates of non-exempted categories, their form will not be accepted.

(6) ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA/CONDITIONS:-

- (i) **Age** Between 18 to 25 years as on last date of online application. Relaxation in respect of the candidates for SC/ ST/ OBC and other special categories of personnel in accordance with the instructions issued by Central Govt from time to time.

ii) One year certificate course from Industrial Training Institute or Government affiliated Vocational Institute with at least one year experience in the trade.

- (2) For trades of Constable(Cobbler), Constable(Tailor), Constable(Washerman), Constable(Barber), Constable(Sweeper) and Constable(Kho/Syo)

- (a) Matriculation or equivalent from a recognized Board;
- (b) Must be proficient in respective trade;
- (c) Must qualify trade test in the respective trade conducted by recruitment board.

- (3) For the trades of Constable(Cook), Constable(Water Carrier) and Constable(Water)

- (a) Matriculation or equivalent from a recognized Board;
- (b) National Skills Qualifications Framework (NSQF) level II Course in food production or Kitchen from National Skill Development Corporation or from the Institutes recognized by National Skill Development Corporation.

- (ii) Educational certificate other than State Board/Central Board should be accompanied with Government of India notifications declaring that such qualification is equivalent to Metric /10th class pass for service under Central Government.

Note-1. The candidates who applied for the trades of Constable, Constable(Water Carrier) and Constable(Waiter) must have passed National Qualifications Framework (NSQF) Level I Course in food production or Kitchen, National Skill Development Corporation or from the Institutes recognized by National Skill Development Corporation as on or before the cut-off date i.e., 23-06-2025.

Note-2. Candidates, who have not acquired the essential educational qualification as on the stipulated date (i.e., 23-06-2025) will not be eligible and need not apply.

- (iii) Women candidate who as a result of tests is found to be pregnant 12 weeks standing or over, shall be declared temporarily unfit and appointment held in abeyance until the confinement is over. The vacancy against which a women candidate was selected should be kept reserved for her. She should be re-examined for PET six weeks after the date of confinement, subject to the production of the medical certificate of fitness from a registered medical practitioner.
- (iv) Original documents/testimonials of candidates will be checked by the Board of Officers and only eligible candidates will be go to the next stage.
- (v) Any candidate found under influence of any energetic medicine during PET will be debarred from the further process of recruitment. Candidates are advised to keep in mind their own physical stamina and endurance level. BSF will not be responsible for any Unforeseen incident occurring during PET as a consequence of consumption of performance enhancing drugs/injections or other reasons.

Note-I : No physical efficiency test will be held for Ex-serviceman.

Note-II : PET will be only qualifying in nature and it will not carry any marks.

(B) 2ND PHASE OF EXAMINATION I.E. WRITTEN EXAMINATION

- (i) Successful candidate in the first phase examination i.e. PST & PET will be called to appear in second phase of examination i.e. Written Examination which will be conducted at the various Examination Centres through OMR or Computer Based. There will be one composite paper for two hour duration and candidates will be communicated through E-Mail address/ SMS for call letters through online.
- (ii) The Written Examination will be of 100 marks containing 100 questions (qualifying marks 35% for UR Category/EWS & Ex-Servicemen and 33% for SC/ST/OBC) will consist of CBT (Computer Based Test).
- (iii) The question paper will be Objective Type containing 100 questions with multiple choices on OMR sheet or Computer and shall be consisting of the following subjects -

- (i) All candidates are required to fill and shade, name, roll number, date of birth, language, Post/Trade, category in the Computer during Computer based examination.

(iii) While applying the post of Constable (Cook), Constable (carrier) and Constable (Waiter), candidates should be very careful and must exercise due diligence while providing information about Non-Skills Qualifications Framework (NSQF) level-I Course in production of Kitchen certificate from National Skill Development Corporation or from the institutes recognized by National Development Corporation. If there is any variation of course name or level of certificate mentioned by the candidate in the Online Application Form and NSQF level-I certificate submitted by them at the time of Document Verification, their candidature will be cancelled forthwith and they will not be allowed to participate in the Detailed Medical Examination.

(b) TRADE TEST :-

The candidates who apply for the trade listed below at Sri No (ii) to (iv) and qualified PST/PET will be put through the respective Trade Test only. Candidates applied for the remaining trades are need not to undergo trade test. However, they will be considered for the applied trade on production of certificate as mentioned against their trade. Candidate will be allowed to appear for one trade only as entered in the application form. The Trade Test will be qualifying in nature and it will not carry any marks.

Detailed Medical Examination -

- (i) The candidates who qualify all the above stages i.e. PST, PET, Documentation, Trade Test and Written test will put through Detailed Medical Examination (DME) which will be carried out by Medical Board of Officers to assess their physical & medical fitness.
- (ii) The medical examination of candidates will be carried out as per revised uniform medical guidelines issued by MiA vide UO No. A VI-1/2014-Recd/SSB dated 20.05.2016 as amended from time to time.
- (iii) Candidates have to qualify all the stages of the third phase examination one by one. Any candidate not qualified any of the stage of examination, he/she will be eliminated from the recruitment process.

- (vi) All candidates declared unfit during Detailed Medical Examination (DME) will be allowed to undergo Review Medical Examination (RME), provided they give their written consent by appending their signature on the intimation indicating the reasons for being unfit. The appeals for Review Medical Examination (RME) will be preferred in the name of Appellate authority of concerned Recruiting Agency (RA).
- (vii) The consent in prescribed proforma for RME duly signed by the candidate should be submitted within 24 hours after he/she is informed of his/her unfitness in DME.
- (viii) Recruiting Agencies (RA) will endeavor to keep the venue for RME in the vicinity of a Composite Hospital of CAPFs or Government Medical College/Hospitals, for facilitating specialist opinion/ investigations etc. if required.

(B). CONDITION FOR ECONOMICALLY WEAKER SECTION (EWS)

According to the Department of Personnel & Training (DoP&T) Office Memorandum No 36039/1/2019-Estt (Req) dated 31.01.2019, "The person belonging to EWSs who are not covered under the scheme of reservation for SCs, STs and OBCs and whose family has gross annual income below Rs. 8.00 lakh (Rupees Eight Lakh only) are to be identified as EWSs for benefit of 10% reservation in direct recruitment in civil posts and services in the Government of India."

Candidates availing the 10% reservation allocated for Economically Weaker Section (EWS) should submit a valid INCOME & ASSET CERTIFICATE as per the specimen attached at Annexure-VII.
